Dear Lower Mount Bethel Township resident,

WM is proud to provide you with waste and recycling collection services. The Collection Calendar on the back of this brochure shows the service dates for 2022, so please keep this guide as a handy reference throughout the year.

Weekly Waste Collection

Waste and one (1) bulk item will be picked up once per week on either Tuesday or Thursday. Please check the map on the Township website at www.lowermtbethel.org to see whether your pickup day is Tuesday or Thursday. Please bag all waste before placing in your cart. All carts and items must be at the curb no later than 6 a.m. on your collection day. Keep 4 feet between carts and other obstacles - trees, mailbox, light poles, cars, etc.

Bulk item Collection

Only one (1) bulk item per week will be picked up. Bulk items include a mattress, box spring, chair, bookshelf, appliance, microwave, etc. Mattresses and box springs must be wrapped in plastic for pickup. Place your bulk item at the curb with your waste on your collection day. NOTE: Any bulk item containing refrigerants (refrigerator, air conditioner, dehumidifier) must have the Freon removed by a Certified Technician and a sticker of certification must be placed on the unit. No items will be collected without a sticker.

Construction debris

Residents are permitted to dispose of one (1) container or bundle of debris each week. Please place at the curb before 6 a.m. on your waste collection day.

Recycling Collection

Recycling will be picked up every other week on either Tuesday or Thursday on the same day as your trash collection. Please place recyclables directly in your container loose - do not bag recyclables. Flatten all cardboard boxes so they fit in your recycling container. Please see the adjacent page for acceptable items and tips to Recycle Right. If you need a recycling bin, contact the Township at (610) 252-5074.

Yard Waste

Yard waste is picked up weekly on your waste collection day. Yard waste includes leaves, small branches and trimmings. Residents are allowed two (2) containers or bags of yard waste each week for disposal and they should be placed at the curb prior to 6 a.m. on your waste collection day.

WM uses WFMZ weather cancellation services during inclement weather for cancellations or delays. Any delay or cancellations of service will be posted on WFMZ.com and shown on the WFMZ-TV Channel 69. If your service day is cancelled, your collection will be the following day. Household Hazardous Wastes and Electronics are NOT ACCEPTED

Toxic chemicals, pesticides, oil-based paints, automotive batteries, fuels or fluids must be disposed of properly. With PA state law, TVs, computers, laptops, monitors and electronics cannot be collected. Please refer to the Northampton County website at
